Breast Enlargement by means of autologous fat transplantation

Breast augmentation using autologous fat transplantation often occurs in multiple surgical sessions. The fat is extracted from the body from various regions, specially processed and reintroduced around the breast. With this method, a moderate enlargement of the breast is possible, without using foreign material.

The fat is removed from various regions in the body using the technique of liposuction. This also offers the benefit of enhancing the silhouette and shape of the body.
