Liposuction

The liposuction procedure involves the use of fine instruments (or cannula) to suck up any accumulation of fat in order to harmonize the body silhouette. The cannulae are introduced through very small incisions, and a special solution of fluid is introduced. This fluid is known as the tumescent fluid, and it anaesthetises the region, minimises bleeding and facilitates the process of liposuction. This procedure can be carried out under local anaesthesia under certain circumstances. We commonly use the Microaire device in these procedures.
